Why Coach Wooden?

Coach Wooden brings over 26 years of coaching experience spanning all levels from high school to the NCAA Division I collegiate level. This includes over twenty years of experience as a coach at the collegiate level. He has a total of seven years of experience as an NAIA head coach and fourteen years of experience as an assistant basketball coach at the Division I, Division II, Division III, NAIA, and Junior College levels. During his career, he has been involved with two programs where he established new records for program wins.

Over the past year, Coach Wooden has served as an assistant coach at the University of Iowa where they had their first winning season since 2018. Prior to his time at Iowa, he served as the Head Men's Basketball Coach at UCLA. During that time, he led the program through the transition from NCAA Division II to NCAA Division I. Prior to his appointment at UCLA, Coach Wooden was the Associate Head Coach at Hood College where they finished the 2013-14 season with the most wins in school history. Hood also finished in first place in their region and played in the NIAC championship game.

Coach Wooden served as the Associate Head Coach at Ohio University from 2010 to 2011, helping lead the program through a successful transition from NAIA to becoming a full-time member of NCAA Division II. He also served as the Head Men's Basketball Coach at Maine College, an NAIA member school, from 2007 to 2010. He became the school's all-time leader in winning percentage at .659. Maine College competed for the conference title twice, reached the NAIA National Tournament twice, and were ranked nationally in the Top 25 all three years, with #7 being the highest ranking in school history. They averaged 20+ wins a year while graduating 96% of their student-athletes.

Coach Wooden runs a basketball program based on integrity and high expectations. His experiences have prepared him for the day-to-day demands required in a head coaching position. The experience he has gained as a player, coach, and educator at the NAIA and NCAA levels have taught him the positive impact a coach can have on a student-athlete's life. He also enjoys the opportunity to be involved on campus and in the community, promoting the college and basketball program.


